

RULES AND GUIDELINES

Chartwell Cherokee Project Graduation Event

**** PLEASE READ - IMPORTANT INFORMATION ****



- The event takes place the evening of the commencement ceremony. The event will be held at Chartwell Swim Club the night of graduation from 10pm until 2am.
- If the graduation ceremony takes place and inclement weather begins after the ceremony, the event will be relocated to The Blue Barn from 10pm to 2am.
- Graduates must check in no later than 11:00 pm.
- No matches, cigarettes, lighters or water bottles allowed.
- All bags will be checked at the time of entry. Identification of alcohol, weapons and/or illegal substances will be subject to response from local law enforcement and result in immediate expulsion from the premises.
- Once on premises, attendees are unable to leave the event prior to 1am. In the event of an emergency, attendees may leave only if accompanied by a parent or guardian with valid ID.
